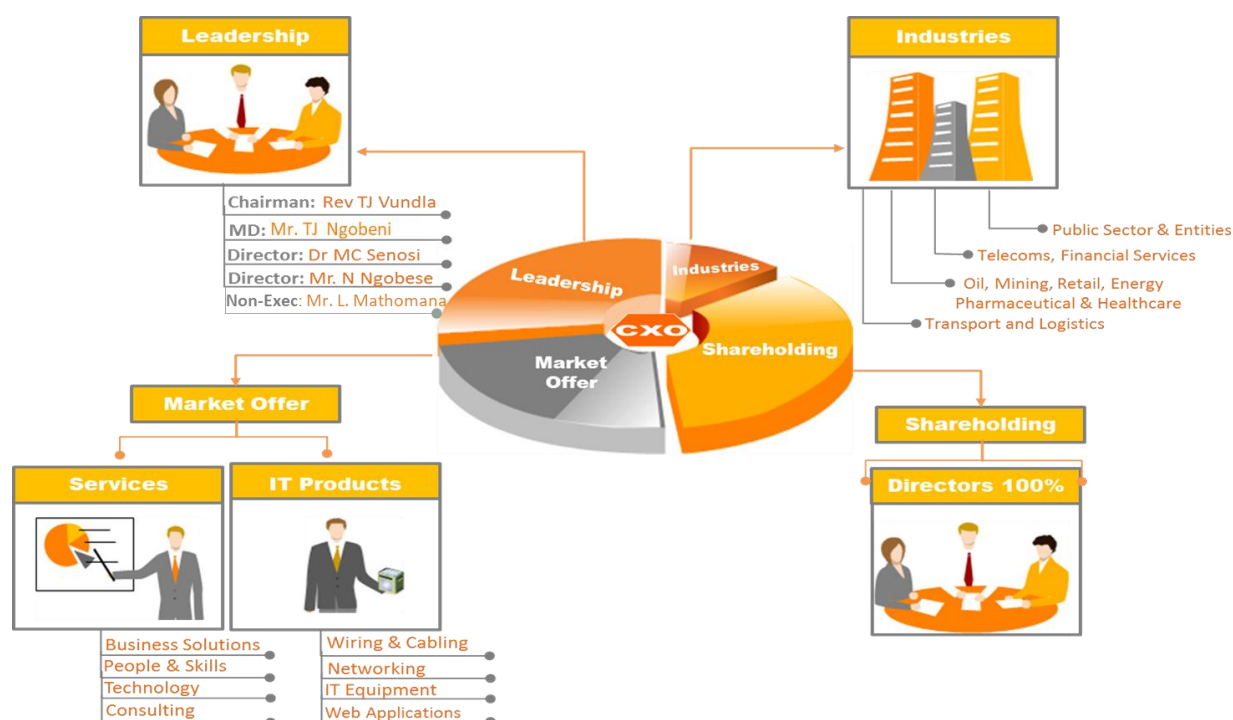


Figure 1: CXO Company Structure

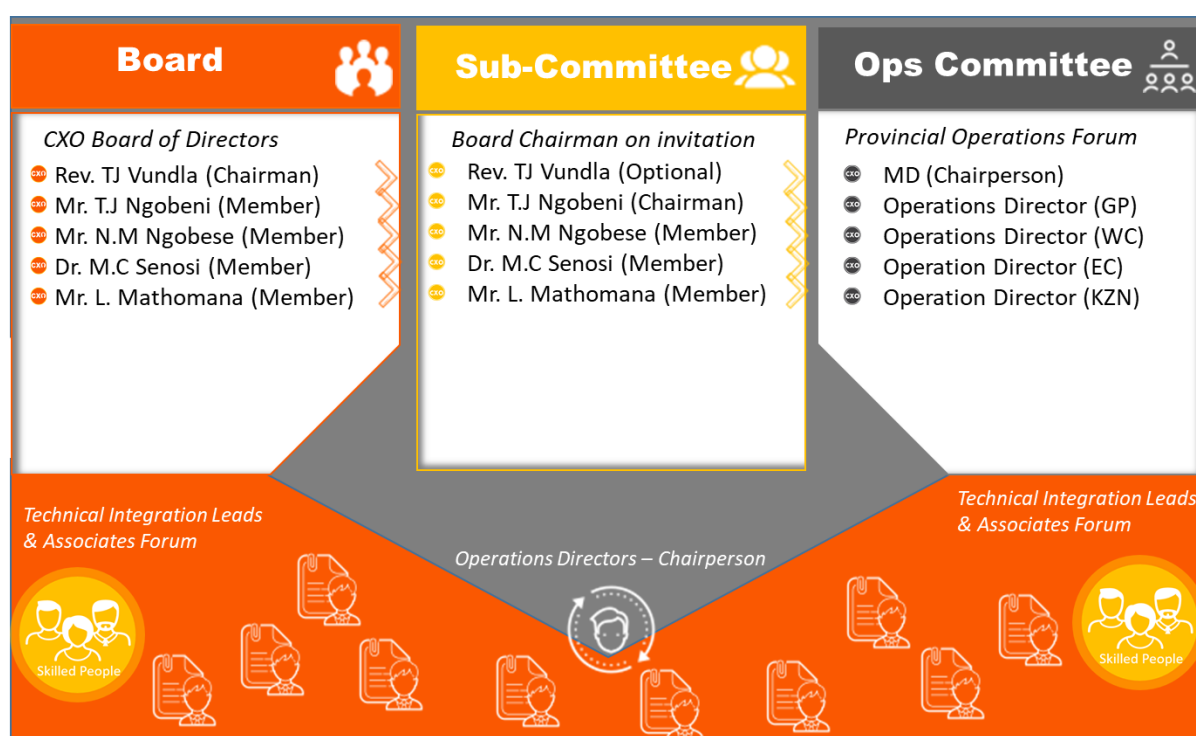


Figure 7 CXO Governance Structure:
